

The proposed motion for the public statement of our concerns is:

The Members of the First Unitarian Universalist Society of San Francisco, a faith community that values pluralism, upholds the worth and dignity of each person, and believes we are all interconnected, affirm our 2025 commitment to being an Apartheid-Free Congregation. We the members:

- Believe that all forms of religious and racial oppression and violence, including antisemitism, Islamophobia, apartheid, and genocide, are immoral and cannot be tolerated.
- Believe that the mistreatment of Palestinians living in Gaza is immoral, ongoing, and cannot be tolerated.
- Believe that standing up against the immoral acts of the current Israeli government should not be taken as a criticism of Jewish people. We also believe that opposing the actions of the current Israeli government should also not in any way be construed as approval of the immoral acts of the Hamas organization, specifically, but not limited to, the Hamas attacks of October 7, 2023.
